- Who? Any Archer Glen student (grades K-5) 2010
- What? A great way to study and learn the world's countries. Each student chooses the level at which they want to participate and is issued a passport to track their progress. Students receive monthly study maps indicating the countries to study for the month. One Tuesday a month, students attend a "Check Day" to show off their skills by correctly identifying their countries. **The first "check day" will be February 23rd in room (portable) #21.**
- When? NOW! Complete the registration form and return it to your teacher or the office. You will receive your February study map and additional information shortly after your registration is received. Attend "Check days" on the **last Tuesday of each month**, before school **at 7:30 a.m.** to test your skill.
- How? Use your free time to study and learn the country names and locations shown on your monthly map.
- Why? Learn about our worldwide neighborhood! At the end of the school year, you will take home a passport showing your progress. Then next year you can work on learning more countries at a higher level, plus review what you learned this year

*Each participant will choose their individual LEVEL of study for the Passport Club.
Don't forget to write your LEVEL choice on your registration form (below).*

LEVEL ONE: This is an "introductory level", for any student who wants to focus on about five countries per month. Even Kindergarteners can have success at this level. Most LEVEL ONE countries are large and fairly well known.

LEVEL TWO: An "intermediate level" involving ten countries per month.

LEVEL THREE: This "advanced intermediate" level involves fifteen countries per month. It will include some of the lesser known countries and island groupings.

LEVEL FOUR: At this very challenging "expert level", the student will learn about twenty-five countries each month.

LEVEL FIVE: This is the highest level for the true "geo-wizard". It is the level where they really start to explore what they have learned. The students locate all the countries in levels one through four, plus corresponding capitals for all countries in Level one.
